The bagged lunches were donated to two local food banks including the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank and Feeding America Southwest Virginia, and will be distributed to local schools and others in need within the community of Hot Springs, Va. An official **GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS** adjudicator verified the count.

This **GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS** title attempt was part of Food Lion Feeds' commitment to provide 500 million meals to individuals and families in need by the end of 2020.
