SALISBURY, N.C.--(<u>BUSINESS WIRE</u>)--Food Lion is voluntarily recalling its 7.75 oz. Food Lion Dill Pickle Chips with UPC number 3582610392 because the manufacturer has alerted us that the product contains milk, a known allergen, that is not declared on the label.

While there have been no reports of illnesses to date, the product is being recalled as a precautionary measure after the manufacturer of the product indicated the potential risk.
