Today, Food Lion honored a Charlotte teacher and Martin Luther King Jr. Middle School with awards at the 2016 Food Lion /CIAA Education Day highlighting their community impact.

The free event was attended by hundreds of middle and high school students at the Charlotte Convention Center. Students listened to Food Lion leaders about why they should stay in school to better their chances at a good career and the company recognized more than 50 students who were in attendance and had a 4.0 or above in academics.

In addition to the career advice and coaching provided by Food Lion leaders, the company also presented Ranson IB World Middle School history teacher, Calvin Johnson, with the Food Lion Top Educator Award.
