- •11:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m. A customer celebration will be held at the Food Lion store at 8508 Liberty Rd. in Randallstown, Md. Customers can enjoy games, samples and giveaways. This event is open to the public.
- •2 p.m. until 4 p.m. A team will be at Camden Yards at Eutaw Street in Baltimore, Md., handing out Food Lion pompoms and sunglasses to fans heading to the Orioles game. This event is open to the public.
